# Matt's top tip



#### AANZETA COMMENCEMENT

The ASEAN-Australia-New Zealand Free Trade Agreement (AANZFTA) finally spluttered to the start line on January 1st 2010 with eight participating countries - Australia, New Zealand, Malaysia Myanmar (Burma), Brunei, Philippines, Vietnam and Singapore.

The AANZFTA will include imports from Thailand on March 12th 2010.

Only imports and exports from these countries will be eligible for preferential duty treatment on and from the relevant date of commencement, provided the goods meet the requirements of the Rules of Origin, Consignment (or Shipment) Provisions and, most importantly, that the importer has the requisite AANZFTA Certificate of Origin.

Regarding the commencement of the FTA for Indonesia, Cambodia and Laos, Australian Customs has advised that the FTA will include these countries 60 days after they have notified the Australian Government that they have completed their domestic legislative process on implementing the FTA.

#### **DUTY RATE CHANGES**

Just a reminder that, on January 1st 2010, a number of Customs Duty Rate Reductions came into force - mainly in the TCF and automotive categories.

### **For TCF**

- if goods were 17.5% prior to 1/1/2010, this duty rate has reduced to 10%
- if goods were 10% prior to 1/1/2010, this duty rate has reduced to 5%
- if goods were 7.5% prior to 1/1/2010, this duty rate has reduced to 5%

### For Motor Vehicles and Motor Vehicle parts

• if these goods had a duty rate of 10% prior to 1/1/2010, this duty rate has reduced to 5%.



# New Vessel Traffic Services System for Sydney Ports

Sydney Ports Corporation has invested a cool \$12 million in a new world class Vessel Traffic Services (VTS) system to be based at Port Botany and fully operational by May 2011.

The new VTS system incorporates the latest technology for premium tracking and surveillance of all vessels, including over 4,500 international shipping movements each year. It will also improve the safety and efficiency of commercial vessel traffic movements in Port Botany and Port Jackson.

The VTS system accurately tracks all vessels and combines information received from multiple sensors including radar, CCTV, VHF and AIS technology, creating an integrated traffic image. It will better protect the marine environment by reducing the risk of accidents.

### **DUTY DRAWBACK**

Are you aware that the Australian Customs & Border Protection Service operates a Duty Drawback scheme?

If Customs Duty is paid on imported goods and those imported goods are either

- a) re-exported in the same condition as imported or
- b) exported as a further manufactured product or
- c) exported as part of another manufactured product, the exporter (even if they are not the importer) is entitled to a Drawback (refund) of the Customs Duty paid on the imported goods.

Even in circumstances where the exporter is not aware of exactly how much Customs Duty the importer paid, it may still be possible to claim back Customs Duty. Exporters have up to four years from the date of exportation to lodge their Duty Drawback claims.

If you think that you may be entitled to claim Duty Drawback on any exports, please give us a call 02 9669 3011 and we will explain the rules and requirements for making a claim.

Please note that it is AC&BPS and ATO policy not to grant Duty Drawback for GST paid on imports. Duty Drawback does not apply to goods that are used in Australia after importation.

## TRADEX

Tradex is a scheme administered by AusIndustry (part of the Department of Innovation, Industry, Science and Research) and an alternative to the Duty Drawback Scheme.

Under Tradex, importers can obtain an exemption from Customs Duty and GST on imported goods where those goods are going to be re-exported in their imported condition or used, lost or wasted in the manufacture of other goods that are later exported.

To benefit from the scheme, importers need to apply to AusIndustry for a Tradex Order. Once the Tradex Order is approved, we can include that number on your Customs Entry to claim exemptions for goods that you identify as relevant. This will decrease costs for importers.

# **DUMPING DUTY**

In the last edition of Bare Facts we provided a list of goods currently subject to Dumping Duty. Since that time, Dumping Duty on toilet paper from Indonesia and China has been reviewed and removed.

Importers who paid Dumping Duty on toilet paper are now entitled to claim a refund. Please contact us if this affects you.

## TARIFF CONCESSION ORDERS FOR BED LINEN

In 2006 and 2007, the Australian Customs Service (as it was then) revoked a number of Tariff Concession Orders (TCOs) for Bed Linen. After an appeal against these revocations, the Administrative Appeals Tribunal decided that the decision to revoke the TCOs was invalid.

As a result, the ACS is restoring the TCOs. However, due to changes in legislation, the restored TCOs will only be valid for imports entered and duty paid on or before October 3rd 2007.

Importers of Bed Linen that meet the terms of these TCOs which were entered and the Duty paid on or before October 3rd 2007 may be eligible for a refund. If you think this includes you, please let us know urgently as the time frame for making a claim is limited.

### BAN OF HCFC PRE-CHARGED AIR-CONDITIONERS

Environment Australia has announced that from July 1st 2010, the importation of air-conditioners (whether they are stand-alone or incorporated in other equipment e.g. in motor vehicles) pre-charged with HCFC Gas will be banned - even if the importer has a Pre-Charged Equipment Licence.

Please be aware that the importation of this equipment will apparently become absolutely prohibited on and from July 1st 2010 with three exceptions:

- Chillers charged with HCFC 123
- Replacement parts for existing HCFC equipment (not being complete or substantially complete indoor or outdoor units)
- High Static Ducted Split System components.

Andy in the afternoon for a laugh.


